Background

The Mayors and Council Members Department of the League of California Cities® is seeking enthusiastic, committed elected officials interested in serving on the Executive Committee of the Department. The vacancy will be filled at the Annual Conference in Long Beach in October. The Department's Executive Committee is comprised of a President, First Vice President, Second Vice President and Immediate Past President (all one-year terms) and a State League Director (two-year term).

Qualifications

The Nominating Committee will use the following information as a basis for selection:

- The individual's professional reputation;
- The individual's perspective on city service;
- Whether the individual has demonstrated a commitment to serving and strengthening the Department;
- The individual's depth of knowledge of and experience with city government; and
- The individual's involvement in intergovernmental activities.

Role/Responsibility and Terms of Office

Each of the Executive Committee positions is a one year term with the intention of succeeding to the President position.

The First Vice President shall act in the place and stead of the President during the President's absence or inability to act. The First Vice President shall be responsible for overseeing the Strategic Planning effort of the Department and shall perform any other duties assigned by the President.

The Second Vice President position is a one-year term and responsibilities include acting in the President's or First Vice President's absence or inability to act. The Second Vice President is responsible for overseeing the Mayors and Council Members' Academy (MCA) and for performing any other duties assigned by the President.

The Selection Process

Applications will be reviewed by the Nominating Committee (appointed by the current Executive Committee), and a proposed 2016/2017 Executive Committee slate will be presented for vote at Annual Conference. Nominations for the vacancy will also be open from the floor at the Department Business Meeting at Annual Conference.
