Public Records Practices After the *San Jose* Decision

This webinar will provide an overview of the California Supreme Court's decision in the *San Jose v. Superior Court* case relating to public records. The presentation will explain why the Court ruled that records on public employees' and officials' personal accounts and devices may be subject to the California Public Records Act. The presentation will also address what kind of policies and practices local agencies could consider adopting and implementing to comply with the decision. Finally, the presentation will highlight and discuss some questions left unanswered by the decision. The presentation will be given by Jolie Houston, chair of the League's California Public Records Act Committee, and HongDao Nguyen, who co-authored the League's amicus briefs in the *San Jose v. Superior Court* case.
