## SB 1421 Peace Officer Personnel Records: An Update on the Latest Developments

For decades, California peace officer personnel records could be obtained only through the *Pitchess* motion procedure. Senate Bill 1421 (2018) allows public access under the California Public Records Act to peace officer personnel records relating to certain types of frequently high-profile and controversial incidents. Cities are receiving numerous broad requests for these records, some of which seek police records going back decades.

This webinar will offer practical guidance on how to navigate and adapt to the new and rapidly-developing legal environment and will look ahead to what might come next.
