Duane E. Bennett is the former Oceanside City Attorney and General Counsel for the Port of San Diego. He was the first African American appointed as City Attorney in the County of San Diego. He also served as an Assistant City Attorney, Police Legal Advisor and Deputy District Attorney, with broad based experience in governmental law, employment, contracts, land use, insurance, civil rights and civil litigation.

Since retiring as General Counsel from the Port of San Diego in 2012, he has expanded his private law practice and is an experienced arbitrator, mediator and litigator handling employment and commercial disputes involving governmental agencies, financial institutions, shippers, retailers, resorts and hotels. He has served as a mediator for the California Department of Fair Employment and Housing, Orange County Superior Court and as Judge Pro Tem for the San Diego Superior Court.

He currently arbitrates and mediates for the American Arbitration Association, County of Riverside and Riverside County Sheriffs' Association. He serves on the arbitration panel for the San Bernardino Civil Service Commission.
