- Serve on League Policy Committees as a Department Representative
- Prepare League Amicus Briefs or Letters for the Legal Advocacy Program
- Assist with the Department/CEB Municipal Law Handbook as a Chapter Chair, Contributor or Reviewer
- Follow and Post Regularly on the California City Attorneys Forum
- Serve as a Department Volunteer to Mentor Colleagues Across the State
- Participate in Local City Attorneys' Department Division Activities and Events
- Serve as a Department Officer to Lead on Implementing the Department's Goals and Objectives
