

## **FOLLOW THE REGULATORY ROAD**

- Released Sept. 2016
- Only guidance Potential benefits: "safety, mobility, and sustainability"
- 4 Sections, including Model State Policy
- Safety Assessment Letter
  - Voluntary?
- Revised version sent to OMB August 18, 2017













## WHAT ABOUT THE "P" WORD?

- Congress getting involved Good thing?
- H.R. 3388 "SELF DRIVE Act"
  - Preemption Safety vs. Performance?
  - What is an "unreasonable restriction"?????
  - Liability on cities?
- Senate Bipartisan principles
  - prioritizing safety; promoting innovation and reducing roadblocks; remaining tech neutral; clarifying federal and state roles; strengthening cybersecurity; and, educating the public



## **EasyMile Perspective on Existing Regulations**

#### **Federal Level:**

- Impressive action and leadership coming from federal government
- While controversial, it is helpful to delineate federal vs state roles
- Exemptions are unpredictable and processes are still being developed
- Lack of clarity regarding FMVSS

#### **State and Local Level:**

- Leadership approaches vary and it's valuable for states to see what is working
- Challenging for technology providers to address "patchwork of regulations"
- Complicated to navigate existing and future navigations in this dynamic environment



with reduced mobility


No need for additional infrastructure

## Bishop Ranch/GoMentum Station



- Employment center in San Ramon, CA
- Started in March 2017
- Operates in mixed traffic
- Plans to operate on public roads in early 2018



## Arlington, TX



- Transporting people from the sports/entertainment center to a parking lot
- Started in August 2017
- Operates amongst pedestrians on a private roadway
- Longer-term plans to operate on public roads



## Minnesota Department of Transportation



- Winter testing on private roadway
- Starting in November 2017




