Award for the Advancement of Diverse Communities

<u>ELIGIBILITY</u>: Candidates must be a city manager, city administrator, chief administrative officer, or assistant city manager of a California city, and must be nominated by an elected or appointed city official.

CRITERIA FOR AWARD:

To select the individual most deserving of this award, a selection panel will evaluate the following:

- Programs, policies, and/or practices in advancing diversity in the workplace, within the community, and/or within the public management profession.
- Degree of personal involvement and commitment by the individual nominated.
- Innovativeness of the solution.
- Results achieved.
