- Degree of personal involvement and commitment by the individual nominated;
- Innovativeness of the solution; and
- Results achieved from such programs, policies or practices.

DESCRIPTION OF AWARD ENTRY

Applicants can submit up to three programs, policies or practices. Applicants shall submit only one program for each of the three categories:

- The advancement of diversity within the community; and
- The advancement of diversity within the public management profession.

On no more than three pages, describe the following:

- The challenge, need or concern that prompted the development of the program.
- The steps taken to address the challenge.
- How the program's objectives were met, highlighting the involvement of stakeholders and partners in the solution.
