How to Access COVID-19 Response Funds Through Community Development Block Grants

Please join the League of California Cities, the California Association for Local Economic Development (CALED), and the California Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) to learn how your city can access coronavirus response funding.

Approximately [\\$18.7 million in new federal funds](#) for the Community Development Block Grant Coronavirus Response Round 1 (CDBG-CV1) is now available. Assistance types include:

- Businesses and microenterprises/economic development
- Public services
- Acquisition of real property to be used for treatment or recovery of infectious diseases
- Medical and homeless facility improvements

To be eligible, a city must be a non-entitlement jurisdiction, must not currently be party to an Urban County Agreement, and must have a certified housing element. Applications will be accepted through August 31, 2020.
